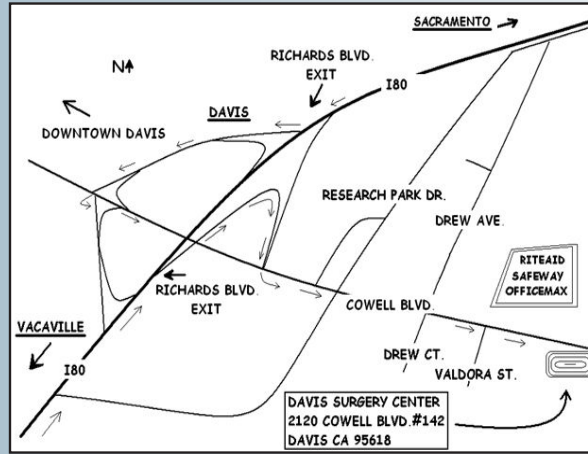

DAY OF SURGERY

- Please arrive promptly at your scheduled arrival time which was confirmed during the pre-operative phone call.
- Remove all make-up and body jewelry and do not use lotions or oils on the day of surgery.
- Bring your co-payment, insurance cards & ID on the day of surgery.
- **Arrange for an adult to drive you home after your surgery.** Someone will need to stay with you for at least 24 hours after having general anesthesia.
- Bring a list of all your regular medications and dosages, both prescription and non-prescription.
- A nurse will provide you with a patient gown, slippers and a space to store your personal belongings in the pre-operative area.
- One visitor may stay with you in the pre-operative area before and after your surgery. During surgery they may wait in the lobby.
- Wear loose, comfortable clothing.

BEFORE SURGERY

PRE-OPERATIVE CALL

• A member of the Anesthesia staff and/or the nursing staff will call a day or two before your surgery to give you detailed, individualized instructions as well as address any questions or concerns you may have. If you have not been contacted 24 hours before your surgery please call Davis Surgery Center (DSC) at (530) 750-7766.

• Notify your surgeon before coming to the Center if there is any change in your physical condition such as fever or cold.

• Do not eat or drink anything after midnight the night before your surgery unless instructed otherwise. You may brush your teeth, remembering not to swallow anything. Do not use mints, chewing gum or tobacco. Failure to follow these instructions may result in cancelation of your surgery.

• Please do not take any medications after midnight, unless instructed otherwise by your physician or office. You may take blood pressure or heart medication the morning of your surgery with a small sip of water.

AFTER SURGERY

• You will stay in the post-operative area until you are in stable condition. For many outpatient procedures this takes 45 minutes to an hour. Once awake, patients will be reunited with family and friends.

• The nursing staff will go over your discharge instructions and you will be given a written copy to take home. Be sure to follow your doctor's orders regarding diet, rest, medication and activity.

• A nurse from the facility will phone you within a few days after your surgery to see how you are and answer any questions you have. Please let us know the best number to reach you prior to discharge.

• If you have received anesthesia, **do not** drive a car, smoke, drink alcoholic beverages, operate machinery or cook for 24 hours after surgery.

• If you have questions or problems after surgery please contact your physician.

COST OF SURGERY

• Davis Surgery Center works with a variety of non-contract insurance providers in order to accommodate our patients' billing needs.

• After your surgery has been scheduled, a member of our staff will contact your insurance carrier for verification of insurance. After determining the extent of your coverage you will be notified of any remaining financial responsibilities including coinsurance and deductibles, if applicable.

• DSC accepts Visa, cash, cashier checks or money orders. Payment arrangements should be made prior to your surgery. Failure to resolve payment issues before the date of surgery could possibly result in the postponement of your surgery.
